Hello! Before you know it, September will be here. You will report to the school yard weather permitting by 7:50 A.M. (not earlier) otherwise report to the gym for morning assembly.

The Kindergarten is dismissed at 2:50. Details regarding dismissal for Kindergarten will be given to you in September.

If your child is staying for after care he/she will remain in the building. They will be brought to the Pre – K 4 room for after care. When picking your child up from after care, ring the Pre-K doorbell on East Fort Lee Road. After identifying yourself, a teacher will walk your child to meet you at the door.

- 5. Family photo (taped to the inside cover of one of the folders that we will be putting a name plate on, this folder will be used for homework papers and keep at home papers and return to school work.)
- 6. A small recent picture of yourself
- 7. 5 #2 sharpened pencils EVERY DAY (these are to be sharpened at home)
- 8. Crayons THE 16 PACK OF CRAYONS ONL NO LARGER BOXES –tape the bottom of the box so it will stay closed
- 9. A coloring book or doddle pad (this will be used after snack or when work is completed, PLEASE REPLACE IF YOUR CHILD HAS COMPLETED THE BOOK)
- 10.A large box of tissues
- 11.Large towel/beach towel for rest time
- 12. Two glue sticks and a pair of SAFETY scissors
- 13. Send \$1.00 in an envelope for a notebook label the envelope with your name/ notebook
